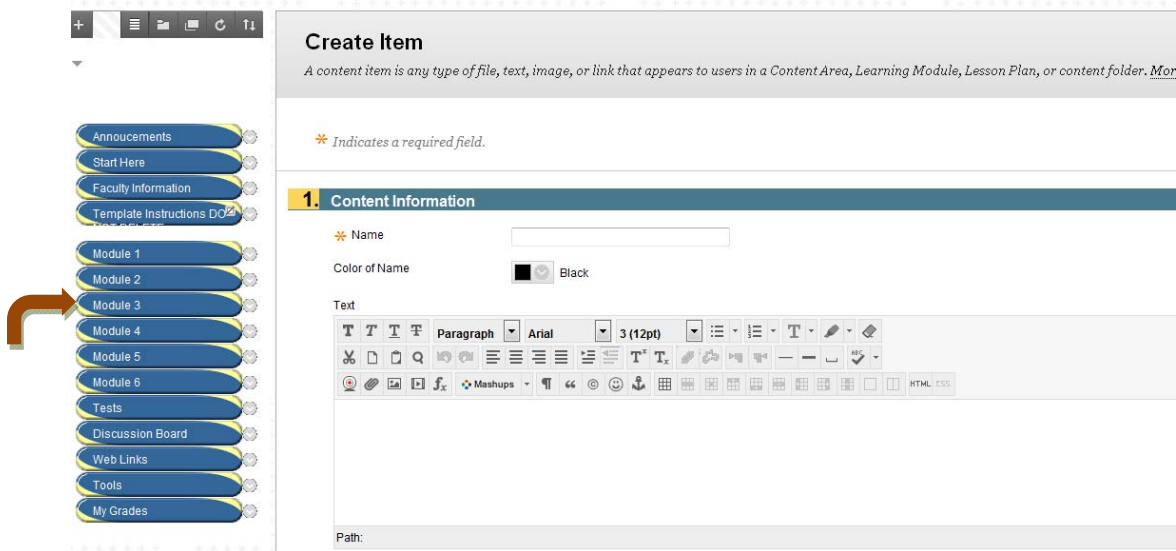


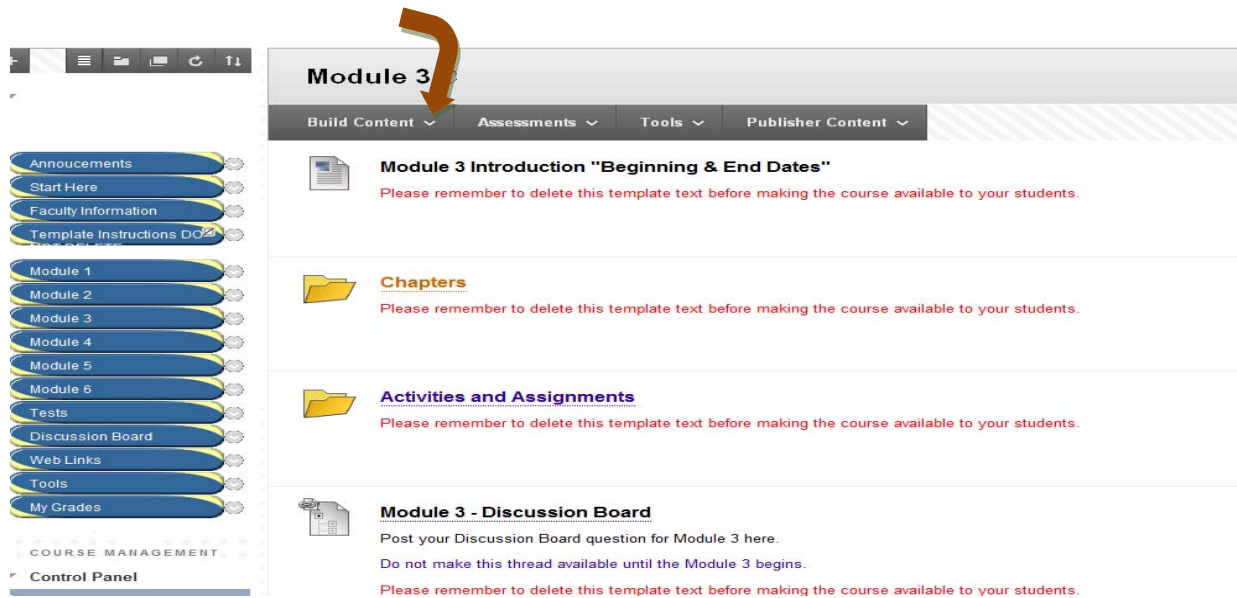
Inserting Streaming Flash Video Into Blackboard

1. Log into your Blackboard account.
2. Select the course to which you intend to add the video.
3. Select the section in which you wish to add the video.

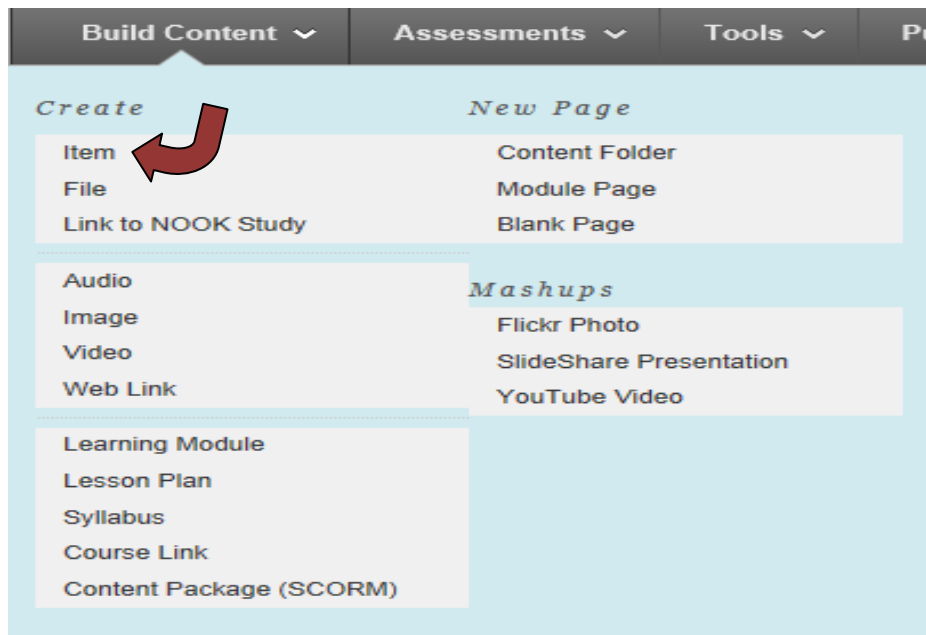


For example if you want to add the video in module 3. Click on it.

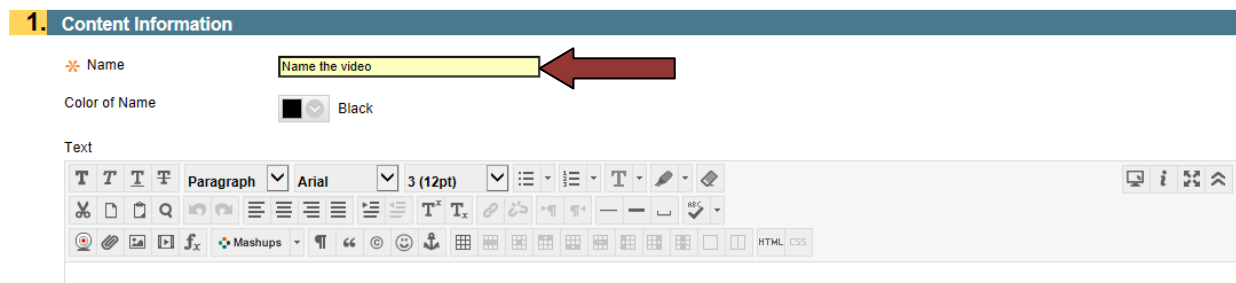
4. Then click on Built content button.



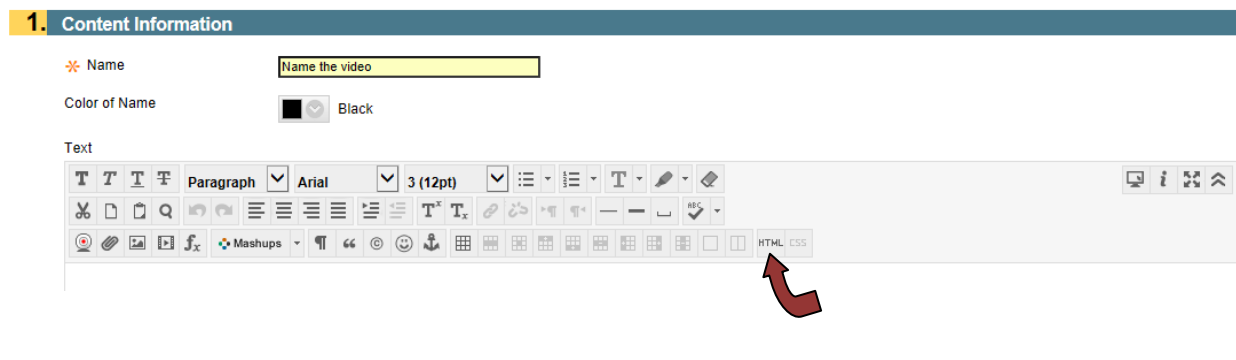
5. Click on the item link



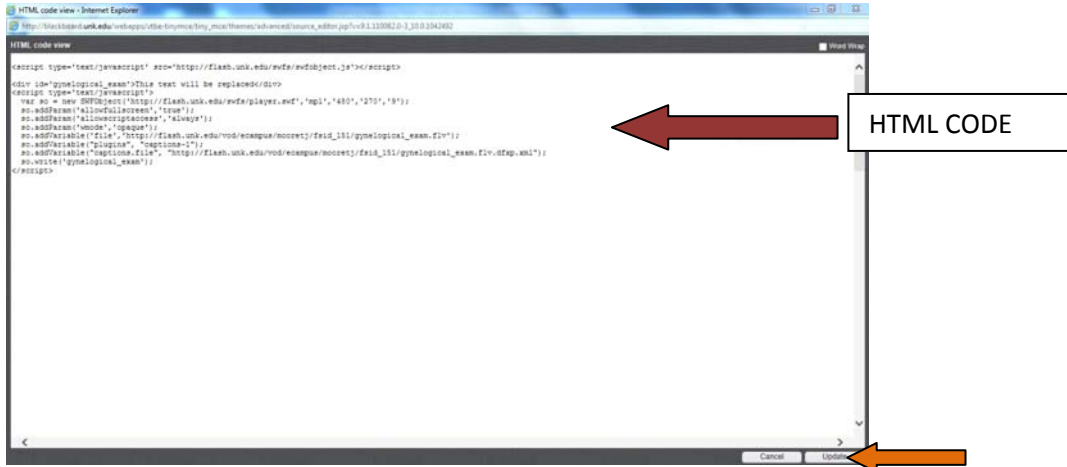
6. Name the video



7. Click on HTML button in Edit tool bar

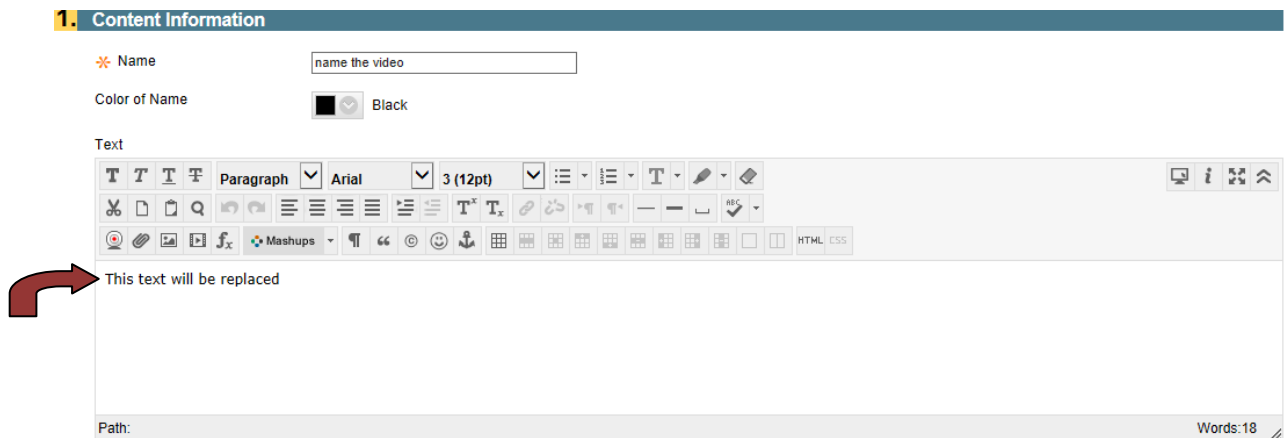


8. Once you click on HTML button you will get a new browser window, here you paste the HTML code that were sent by instructional designer for your video and press update.

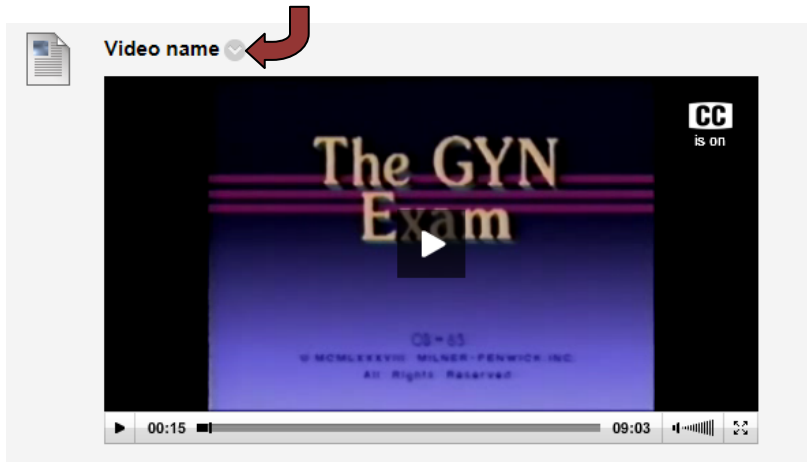


Once you press update browser window will be closed.

9. You will get the below message and in the same page go down and press submit button.



10. Now you see your video.



Suppose if you want to delete the video, press the button near video name where you will get the delete option and you can delete it.
