DR. JOHN MARTIN PETZET is Associate Professor of Music and Director of Choral Activities at the University of Nebraska at Kearney. He conducts the Choraleers, Collegium, Men's and Women's Choruses, and teaches Secondary Choral Methods and Choral Conducting. He is a native of Tulsa, Oklahoma, where he taught middle school and high school for 5 years. Furthermore, he has conducted honor choirs across Louisiana and in Colorado, was invited to teach at the West Texas Choral Workshop, and to teach, present, and conduct at La Universidad Autónoma De Ciudad Juárez and to work with the Anaíma Ensamble Vocal

in Juárez, Mexico. Dr. Petzet has also written two compact disc reviews for the *Choral Journal* and has presented interest sessions in Alabama, Arkansas, Kansas, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Dakota, Oklahoma, Tennessee, Texas, and Utah. He also sang, toured, and recorded with the Kansas City Chorale under the direction of Charles Bruffy during the 2003-2004 season. While performing with the Chorale, he sang on the Chandos recording of Alexandre Grechaninov's *Passion Week*, which won a Grammy for Best Engineered Classical Album. He resides in Kearney, Nebraska with his lovely wife Jennifer and his 3 children: Zachary, Andrew, and Catherine.



DR. MIRIM KIM is a collaborative pianist who loves to make music with people and inspire audiences. She recently joined the University of Nebraska at Kearney as a Collaborative Pianist. Dr. Kim graduated summa cum laude with her Bachelor of Music in Piano at the Sookmyung Women's University. She holds a master's degree in Piano from Indiana University, where she served as an Assistant Instructor. She also earned her master's and Doctor of Musical Arts degree in Collaborative Piano at The University of Texas at Austin, where she served as a Teaching Assistant.

Her performance career as a collaborative pianist includes various styles of performance in vocal, instrumental, choir, band, and orchestra. She was a collaborative pianist for many music festivals, such as Domaine Forget International Festival, Castleman Quartet Program, SongFest, and Music Academy of The West. Since 2021, she has collaborated with the Tallgrass Chamber Choir directed by Dr. Jacob Narverud and recorded numerous choral works by Jacob Narverud, Elaine Hagenberg, Josh Sparkman, and Aidan Vass. Dr. Kim also plays the piano and directs the chancel choir at Kearney First United Methodist Church.
