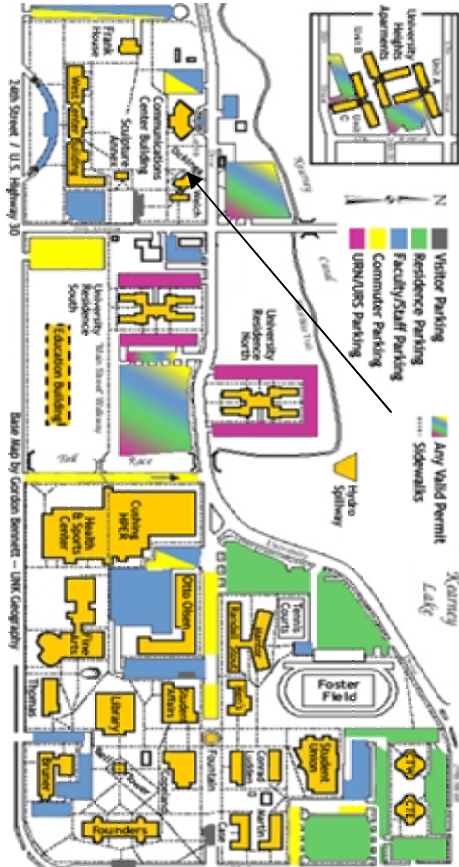


How to Get to the Conference

Getting to the Area: From I-80, take the #272 exit and go North (This is 2nd Avenue). The streets are all numbered so you will see the Holiday Inn on the Left. The Wingate is behind the Holiday Inn and if you are staying at the Holiday Inn Express you go South from I-80.

UNK: From 2nd Avenue go North, over the bridge until you get to 25th Street or Highway 30 and turn left. The University is on 9th Avenue.

Ockinga Center: Keep going West on 25th past 9th Avenue. You will pass the Health and Sports Center and UNK's new education building that is under construction on the right. Turn right on 19th Avenue, cross University Drive and you will see Parking Lot #20 on the left. Park there and walk across the street to Ockinga.

The Conference

This is the first University of Nebraska Conference sponsored by the Women's Studies programs at UNL, UNK and UNO. Traditionally UNK has had a Women's Studies conference every other year in connection with their World Affairs Conference. UNL has had the *No Limits Interdisciplinary Conference* every year since 1994, when it was put together by a few dedicated students who wanted to sponsor a conference adhering to the basic tenets of Women's Studies. Each year, the *No Limits* conference at UNL has been host to students and community members involved in Women's Studies from numerous



academic departments and community groups. The *2002 No*

Limits conference begins the tradition of rotating the conference between the three campuses, which allows more opportunities for students and increases collaboration between campuses. *No Limits* does not charge a conference fee, although **pre-registration is required**. Pre-registration begins at **8:30 each day and the presentations begin at 9:am**. *No Limits* is funded by donations from various University Departments. The 2003 conference will be at UNO and the 2004 conference will return to UNL.

Invited Speakers

Adilah Barnes Adilah, an award-winning actor, has over 30 years of acting experience. Although best-known to television audiences for her role as Anne Marie on ABC's "Roseanne" for five seasons, Adilah more recent credits include co-starring roles in *Erin Brockovich* with Julia Roberts, CBS's *City of Angles*



and WBs *Jack and Jill*. Adilah will be presenting her one-woman show, *I Am That I Am: Woman, Black*, an historical portrayal of such important historical and political figures as Sojourner Truth, Harriet Tubman, Maya Angelou and Angela Davis on Friday night March 8 at 7:00 in the UNK Recital Hall. Admission is Free.

Elizabeth Kopp Ms. Kopp is a Swiss lawyer, human rights activist and the Minister of Justice in Switzerland. The Minister of Justice is responsible for the federal police, who among many other duties, fight terrorism. Ms. Kopp will be speaking Friday March 8 at 11:30 on *Women in Politics—What Women Can Contribute*.

Dr. Barbara Lounsberry - Dr Lounsberry will be presenting her talk called "Nancy Drew: Midwestern Heroine to the World on Saturday March 9 at noon. Dr. Lounsberry is a Professor of English at the University of Northern Iowa where she was named the University's Distinguished Scholar in 1994 and Outstanding Teacher in 1998. Dr. Lounsberry is the Nonfiction Editor of The North American Review. She is the author or editor of four books.
