### **Advisory Committees**

- We engaged faculty advisory with a draft identifying 34 faculty positions.
- BAC listened and provided insights on broad categories.
- Both committees submitted recommendations by the Nov. 1 deadline. These were posted publicly.
- Admin Council has reviewed them and given input.
- All documents from the committees and individuals were read.

### 2023 Proposed Budget Process

#### **UNK BUDGET FORUM SEPT. 14, 2023 PRESENTATION**

On Sept. 14, 2023, following the NU Board of Regents and President Ted Carter's request for UNK's response to its <u>Reinvention initiative</u>, Chancellor Doug Kristensen outlined UNK's framework and timeline to meet the FY 2023-24 budget shortfall.

#### STUDENT FORUM OCT. 2, 2023 PRESENTATION

On Oct. 2, 2023, UNK Student Government hosted a student forum to discuss the FY 2023-24 budget shortfall and the proposed elimination of some degrees and faculty positions. Vice Chancellor of Business and Finance Jon Watts and interim Sr. Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs answered questions and outlined UNK's framework and timeline to meet the FY 2023-24 budget shortfall.

## Non-Academic cuts - BAC



- Administrative: \$400,000
- UNK Global: \$400,000
- En. Mgt, Marketing and Student Aff.: \$300,000
- Office Associate Redeployment: \$300,000
- Business & Finance: \$200,000
- Athletics: \$200,000
- Departmental Operating Funds: \$120,000
- Library: \$80,000

### **Next Steps**



Submit the plan to Office of President by Dec. 1
U-wide Zero-based budget review on Dec. 7
Notify personnel in May
All faculty will get at least 1 year (through spring 2025)

Finalize non-academic cuts and any additional faculty cuts in spring 2024
