What is "Faculty-led program"?

The Faculty-led program is specially designed to promote cooperation between Hanyang University and its partner universities. In this program, faculty members and a minimum number of 5 students can come together to HISS. The faculty member can deliver a course(s) of their interest to both their home university students and other international students participating in HISS. All participating students are eligible for a scholarship.

Attention: In case you are not able to meet the requirements for the faculty-led program, we prefer you to teach 2 courses rather than 1. The reason for this is the limited number of housing facilities which are available for international professors.

Faculty-led scholarship for students

All students who participate in a faculty-led program are eligible for a 50% tuition waiver. Students only need to pay KRW 1.400.000 instead of KRW 2.800.000 tuition fee. Including application fee (mandatory) and housing (optional) the total fee will be KRW 1.900.000 (approx. USD 1800 / EUR 1300). Please note that this is information is not shared on our website or brochure so please forward this information to your students!

Student who do not participate in a faculty-led program, but is a student from one of Hanyang's partner universities are also eligible to the scholarship mentioned above. Below you can find an overview for the costs for students.
