RETROACTIVE CREDIT MODERN LANGUAGES DEPARTMENT

EFFECTIVE FALL 2019

Students entering UNK with a particularly high level of achievement in Modern Languages may be awarded credit upon completion of a "validating" course at UNK.

The Department of Modern Languages will allow credit, assigned retroactively, for French/German/Japanese/Spanish after the completion of a validating course in French/German/Japanese/Spanish and subject to the following conditions:

- a) The validating course must be the first college level course completed in French, German, Japanese or Spanish and must be taken at the University of Nebraska at Kearney.
- b) Confirming course numbers for French, German, or Spanish are 201, 205 or an approved 300-400 level (excludes Phonetics, Study Abroad, 388) foreign language course at UNK.
- c) Confirming course numbers for Japanese are 200 and 201.
- d) The student must receive a letter grade of "B-" or better in the validating course and may not repeat the course for the purpose of requesting credits under this policy.
- e) A maximum of 9 credits may be granted in any one language.

After completion of a validating course listed below with a "B-" or better, the student will receive the following credits:
