In 1992 Richard Salmen started a small, independent financial planning practice and today he is a Senior VP and Manager, Financial Planning Services at BOK Financial in Overland Park, Kansas, a team that manages \$600 million in assets for 350 clients. In 2009, as national president of the 26,000 member Financial Planning Association, Salmen helped lawmakers draft new financial regulations after the 2008 banking crisis.
