Emergency Equipment: - The following equipment will be available in the athletic training room located in the club house behind the 3rd base line.

- > Athletic Training Kit
- > Water and Ice Chest w/ bags + wrap
- > Vacuum Splints
 - > There is an **AED** located just inside the double doors on the 3rd base side at field level. A second **AED** is located in the ticket booth at the top of the stadium.

Role of First Responders:

- **Certified Athletic Trainers**
 - > Immediate care of the injured or ill student-athlete.
- **UNK Graduate Students:**
 - > Brings emergency equipment from dugout to A.T.
 - > Activation of EMERGENCY MEDICAL SYSTEM (EMS)
 - ~ Call 911 [provide name; address; telephone number; number of individuals injured; condition of injured individual(s); first aid treatment, specific directions, and other information that may be requested]. **DIRECTIONS TO FIELD ON NEXT PAGE.**
- **Coach / Administrator:**
 - > DIRECT EMS TO SCENE =
 - ~ Open appropriate gates / doors.
 - ~ Designate individual to “flag down” and direct EMS to the scene.
 - > Designate an asst. coach to travel with injured to hospital.
 - > Scene Control: limit scene to first aid providers and move bystanders away from the area.

** If certified Athletic Trainer is not present, the coaching staff that is CPR/First Aid certified will assume immediate care of injured or ill athlete.
