Acceptance into 850 Instrumental lessons

Students desiring acceptance into 850 lessons must apply on their major instrument studied during their undergraduate program.

Students will submit the following materials to the appropriate applied faculty member:

- 1. Repertoire list (containing all solo and chamber works)
- 2. Video link(s) to a recent performance of repertoire representing two contrasting styles.

A panel of 3 faculty (the panel is coordinated by the appropriate applied faculty member) will evaluate the materials and vote on acceptance.

Audition materials must be submitted to the appropriate applied faculty member at least one month prior to the beginning of the semester.

At the conclusion of the semester the student is enrolled in MUS 850, the student must submit a video link of a performance representing material studied during the semester (with accompaniment as appropriate). The applied faculty will evaluate the performance using the undergraduate jury rubric; this form will be kept in the student file. The applied faculty member will be solely responsible for the evaluation of the final performance.
