Graduate Voice Lessons

Acceptance into 850 lessons

Students desiring acceptance into 850 lessons must have had Voice as their principle instrument during their undergraduate programs.

Students will submit the following materials to the appropriate applied faculty member:

- 1. Repertoire list from undergraduate and other post-secondary Voice studies.
- 2. Video link(s) to a recent performance of repertoire representing two contrasting styles and languages.

A panel of 3 faculty (the panel is coordinated by the appropriate applied faculty member) will evaluate the materials and vote on acceptance.

Audition materials must be submitted to the appropriate applied faculty member at least one month prior to the beginning of the semester.

At the conclusion of the semester the student is enrolled in MUS 850, the student must submit a video link of a performance representing material studied during the semester (with accompaniment as appropriate). The applied faculty will evaluate the performance using the undergraduate jury rubric; this form will be kept in the student file. The applied faculty member will be solely responsible for the evaluation of the final performance.
