Enjoy cultural experiences and an **optional excursion** to the Pacific coast of
Costa Rica.

Courses of Instruction

Depending upon their proficiency levels, students will take courses in conversation, grammar, composition, literature and the culture and civilization of Costa Rica. Courses focus on developing students' Spanish skills in reading, writing, listening and speaking. Small class sizes emphasize constant interaction and communication in Spanish.

Workshops

The school offers optional recreational activities such as Latin dance, cooking, conversation sessions, etc. that take place outside of regular class hours and are not mandatory but highly recommended. These workshops take place at the school and are covered in the prices below.

Homestay

Students will live with carefully selected host families in safe residential areas close to the school. Students' host families will provide them with breakfast and dinner as well as laundry service. Students may be placed with other students studying at CRLA.

Optional Excursion

During our stay in Costa Rica, an optional 3-day beach excursion is planned to a small town located on the Pacific coast of Costa Rica. All arrangements will be made by the Costa Rican Language Academy. The cost of this excursion is approximately **\$300** and is **NOT** included in the program fee. Payment for this excursion will be made directly to CRLA by the student. If the student plans on participating in this excursion it should be noted on the application form.

2020 Dates

Arrival: Sunday, May 31st

Departure: 2-week stay – Saturday, June 13th; 4-week stay – Saturday June 27th

Costa Rica Language Academy Fee

The CRLA program fee is **approximately \$900** (two-week) and **\$1600** (four-week), paid directly to CRLA by credit card. It includes the following:

- Four hours of daily coursework, 4 days/week at [CRLA](#)
- All course required materials.
- Homestay program with two meals/day and laundry service.
- Airport transfers within Costa Rica.

Other Expenses

The following expenses are **not** included in the CRLA fee:

- Airfare between the U.S. and San José, Costa Rica*
- Daily lunch and public transportation while in Costa Rica
- Optional 3-day excursion

UNK Fees

- UNK tuition (3/6 hours)
- Modern Languages Study Abroad Program Fee: \$100 (payable to UNK Department of Modern Languages)
- Risk Management Fee (\$33) and mandatory health insurance: \$22.12 (2-weeks) or 44.24 (4-weeks) – forms and payment at the UNK Study Abroad Office.

*Travel Arrangements

Students will arrange their own travel from the US to Costa Rica and may depart the U.S. from the airport of their choice. Approximate round-trip airfare between Omaha and San José, Costa Rica is \$800.

- **Make sure your ticket purchase is for San José COSTA RICA (SJO).**
- **Due to homestay arrangements, plan on arriving on Sunday, May 31 and leaving either June 13th or June 27th.** Otherwise, additional fees may apply.

Other Requirements

There are no academic prerequisites. Students will be required to enroll for 3 or 6 hours of credit through UNK. Financial aid and/or scholarships are applicable for those who apply. Please check with your financial aid advisor and/or scholarship director. A passport is required. **The Department of Modern Languages is offering two scholarships for this program.**
