SUMMER STUDY ABROAD SPAIN La Coruña, Galicia, Spain

June 13-July 4, 2020



Three-week intensive language study in A Coruña

The Department of Modern Languages is offering a three-week summer program in Spain. Participants will study Spanish at the University of A Coruña and enjoy guided visits to sites of interest in the city. A full day visit to neighboring Santiago de Compostela is included.

A Coruña (also known as La Coruña and Corunna), a busy and beautiful city located on the northern coast of Spain, offers a broad array of attractions. It has historical sites, such as the Tower of Hercules, as well as modern attractions and shops, topped off by peaceful sea-side walkways near pristine beaches and a rich culinary tradition.

Students will purchase their own round-trip airline ticket. They will be accompanied by a UNK department coordinator during their stay. Students must arrive in La Coruña at the same time, flight number TBD.

Itinerary

June 12th Leave the US

June 13th Arrival in La Coruña, flight time TBA. Settling in with host families. Opportunity to explore Coruña and the surrounding area.

June 15-July 3rd Three week language course according to your level of Spanish (Monday-Friday)

July 3rd Program concluded

July 4th Fly home

Cost and Payment Schedule

The price of the 25-day program is estimated at \$2,500.

Inclusions:

- Guided day trip to Santiago de Compostela (39 miles from Coruña)
- Lodging and full board for 21 days
- Orientation upon arrival
- Travel to and from school
- Cultural outings around La Coruña
- Dinner out our first week
- UNK travel insurance

Exclusions:

- Round-trip airfare to La Coruña
- Passports and visas
- Non-scheduled additional activities
- Students will pay for 6 UNK credit hours not included in above price
- You may be able to apply money from scholarships you currently hold (check with your scholarship representative or Financial Aid for details)

Payment

A non-refundable deposit of \$500.00 is due by end of January and subsequent payments of \$1000.00 due February 28 and \$1000.00 due on April 1 2018.
