## IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR MUSIC DIRECTORS

Below is pertinent information regarding student auditions for the 2024 University of Nebraska at Kearney Honor Band and Choral Clinic. On behalf of the entire Department of Music, Theatre, and Dance at UNK, I thank you for your efforts in assisting your students with the audition process. We are anticipating an exciting musical and educational day with you and your students on **Monday, January 29, 2024.** 

#### **APPLICATIONS AND AUDITIONS**

Students in grades 10-12 are eligible to audition. If the application does not have the student's grade, the audition may not be accepted. **Students may audition for band OR choir**, <u>but not both</u>. Instrumental students must audition on one instrument only. #### **FORMAT FOR AUDITION RECORDINGS**

- 1. Please use a **single file for each audition.** The entire audition should include **name**, **grade** (**sophomore**, **junior**, **senior**), **school**, **voice/instrument**, scales, and audition excerpts.
- 2. Audition recordings must be in one of the following formats: .mp3, .m4a, or .wma.
- 3. When recording an audition, it is best to use the Pause button between sections of a student's recording so that all parts of the audition remain on the same file. The Stop button may automatically create a new file for each part, requiring the parts to be mixed into one file.
- 4. Review your digital recordings to ensure that they were recorded correctly, that they have the complete audition for each student, and that they are loud enough.

#### **FEES**

A \$30.00 clinic fee is required for each Clinic participant. This fee covers the cost of music, clinicians, dinner, facilities, postage, accompanists, and printing. Send no money with the applications. If one or more of your students are accepted into the Clinic, you will be billed for the fees. All fees must be paid to the Music Department before the Clinic, or your students will not be allowed to participate. Once a student has been accepted into one of the clinic ensembles, the participation fee must be paid since the funds are already encumbered. If the student, for whatever reason, does not participate in the clinic (this includes non-attendance due to sickness) the clinic fee must be paid and is non-refundable.

#### **DEADLINE**

A reminder—all applications and audition recordings must be uploaded no later than Thursday, October 26, 2023. Each year over one thousand students apply for the Honor Clinic, and the procedures delineated here allow for the expedient processing of these applications and audition recordings. Failure to adhere to these procedures may disqualify the students from your school. Upon receipt of your auditions, UNK music faculty will review them and make the selections for the ensembles. We will notify you through an email memo as soon as possible concerning which students have been accepted for the Honor Clinic. The results will also be posted on our website. After being notified as to which of your students was selected for one of the clinic groups, you will receive an invoice for the appropriate fees. The fees are due upon receipt of the invoice. Music will be distributed to each school via email or physical mail. Each student must bring the music to the clinic. All music must be turned in to university personnel at the conclusion of the concert.
