ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

Freshmen must meet **ONE** of the following standards:

- Composite score of 20+ ACT or 1040+ SAT (UNK ACT Code is 2468; SAT Code 6467)
- Or rank in the top 50% of your graduating class
- Or have a 3.0+ cumulative high school GPA

CORE COURSE REQUIREMENTS (1 unit = 1 year)

- **English – 4 units** Intensive reading/writing
- **Math – 3 units** Algebra I, Algebra II, Geometry
- **Social Science – 3 units** American/World History; History/American Government/Geography; Social Science
- **Natural Science – 3 units** Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Earth Science; one lab course required
- **World Language – 2 units** Same language (ex. Spanish I, Spanish II) may be substituted with additional English, Math or Science
- **Elective – 1 unit**
From the other core areas, preferably math

- Apply for admissions at unk.edu/apply which opens August 1 at the beginning of your senior year.
- Pay the \$45 application fee.
- Send ACT/SAT scores and official high school transcripts to UNK.

SPRING

MAR 1, 2025 > **MAR 11, 2025** > **MAY 28, 2025**

Must be admitted for merit-based scholarship consideration

Admitted Student Day and Fraternity Sorority Preview Day

New Student Enrollment begins to register for classes

Move-in to campus housing begins **Aug. 22, 2025**.

First day of classes is **Aug. 25, 2025**.
