Reason: In checking back we discovered that one of the figures submitted on the 2016/17 survey was incorrect and another is missing. The 2016/17 figure for "Preservation services" should have been 139; the 2016/17 figure for "All other operations and maintenance expenses" should have been 283,559. This would have given us a "Total operations and maintenance expenses" should have been 2016/17. The corrected figure would compare more favorably with the current 2017/18 figure of 386,828.
