Membership Criteria

For students:

Membership is open to all who qualify following the completion of at least one semester of University of Nebraska Kearney enrollment at an upper division or graduate student. Students must have a cumulative GPA of 3.2 for undergraduates and 3.5 for graduates, or higher. In addition, students must demonstrate international competency through 2) completion of 36 UNK credit hours, international or intercultural coursework, or b) experience in studying, researching, living or working abroad or involvement in other international endeavors. Annual dues: 1st year membership \$50; renewal \$20

For faculty/staff/administration:

FSA may qualify by teaching courses in international or intercultural studies, and/or personal involvement in international or intercultural affairs, or research in related fields.

Annual dues: 1st year membership \$55; renewal \$25.

Please return the completed application to the office of International Student Services, Welch Hall #101, with a check payable to "Phi Beta Delta at UNK." A receipt will be issued. Applications will be notified as to the status of their application within 10 days. If you do not qualify, your application fee will be fully refunded. Your application fee includes the following benefits: one year headquarters' dues, one year chapter dues, a bronze medallion on a ribbon to be worn at initiation and a Certificate of Membership.
