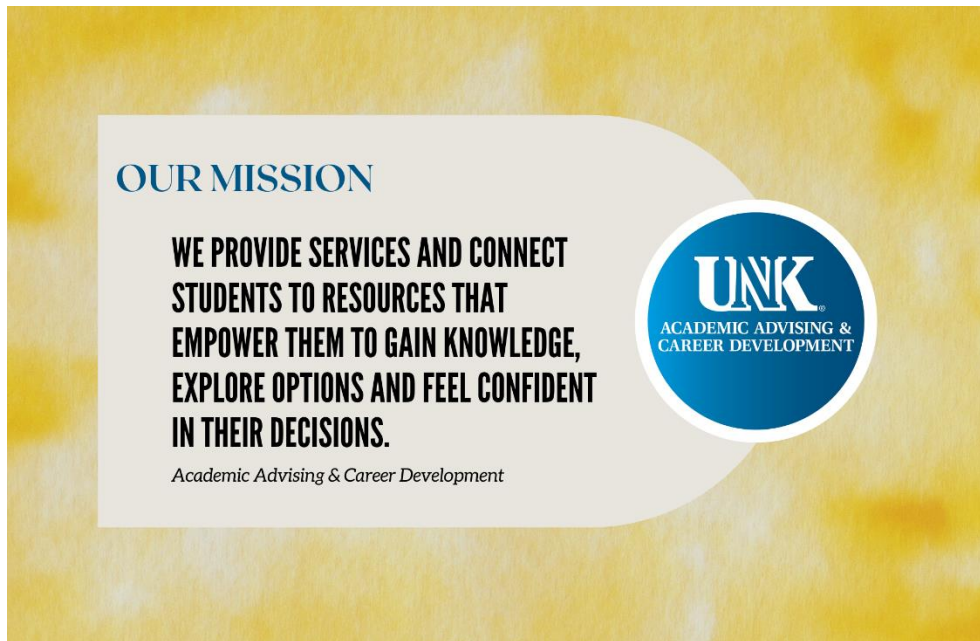

things you should know this month

- Living on campus (contact Residence Life)
- Athletic Eligibility (athletes must be full-time in order to remain eligible)
- Financial Aid
- International Visa Status
