
SAND VOLLEYBALL COURTS

PROCEDURES



GENERAL USAGE

- Courts are available for use by current students, faculty, and staff.
- Community members may use courts when not reserved for campus programs.
- Priority scheduling is as follows:
 - o Campus Recreation & Athletics programs and events
 - Recognized student organizations and campus departments
 - General student/faculty/staff use
- Courts are available on a first-come, first-served basis when not reserved.
- Volleyballs are available for check-out from the UNK Wellness Center. Student ID must be given to check out a volleyball.

RESERVATION REQUESTS

- Reservation requests must be submitted through the Campus Rec Reservation System.
- Campus affiliated reservations:
 - To be eligible to reserve courts, groups must be a recognized student organization, campus department, or equivalent group.
 - Campus affiliated groups will not be charged a rental fee for traditional use. Pending event type, group may be subject to fees.
- Non-campus affiliated reservations:
 - Non-campus affiliated groups may reserve courts but are subject to rental charges, must provide certificate of liability insurance and all users must sign waivers.



POLICIES



COURT RULES

- No glass or sharp objects allowed within the sand volleyball area.
- Users are not permitted to adjust the net height or alter equipment.
- Alcohol, tobacco, and vaping are prohibited.
- Users must clean up trash and return any borrowed equipment.
- Hanging or pulling on nets and poles is prohibited.
- Pets are not allowed on courts.

SAFETY & MAINTENANCE

- Courts may be closed at any time due to weather, unsafe conditions, or scheduled maintenance.
- In case of lightning or severe weather, play must be stopped immediately.
- Damage or maintenance concerns should be reported to Campus Rec staff.
- UNK staff reserve the right to remove individuals or groups violating policies.

ENFORCEMENT

- Failure to comply with court policies may result in loss of court privileges.
- Violations depending on severity may lead to referral to the Student Conduct office.
