## **Renewal Criteria**

- Successfully complete 24 or more semester hours each academic year

*\*Grade point average and hour completion are reviewed at the end of each spring semester to determine renewability. Students are notified via email and paper mail, at their permanent address, if they do not meet the renewal criteria and lose their scholarship.*

## **Reminder**



The Midwest Student Exchange Program is available to students from Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, North Dakota, Ohio, and Wisconsin. Residency is based upon self-reported information on the application for admission.

## **Conditions of the Scholarship**

- Must be a full-time student at UNK (12 or more credit hours) each semester. Failure to enroll for a semester will result in forfeiture of the scholarship. Enrollment status will be checked on the last day of the first week of classes (drop and add week). The scholarship will be cancelled and will be forfeited if you are not at full-time status at that time.
- Waiver will not apply to distance delivered courses.
- Cannot be transferred to another institution, this includes the University of Nebraska Medical Center.
- May be used for summer sessions for less than full-time enrollment.
- Eligibility will end once upon receipt of a bachelor's degree or after eight semesters, whichever comes first.
- Scholarship amount will be based on enrollment status at the end of the first week of classes. The amount will be adjusted if a course is dropped during the institution's refund period.
