

*Provides a \$1,000 tuition waiver for up to eight semesters or until graduation*

## Renewal Criteria

- Cumulative GPA 3.0 or greater
- Successfully complete 24 or more semester hours each academic year.

*\*Grade point average and hour completion are reviewed at the end of each spring semester to determine renewability. Students are notified via email and paper mail, at their permanent address, if they do not meet the renewal criteria and lose their scholarship.*

***If you enroll and receive the Transfer Student Scholarship you will be agreeing to the terms and conditions of the scholarship as described***

## Reminder

The Transfer Student Scholarship is awarded to a transfer student from any institution who has been admitted by April 1 with a cumulative GPA of 3.25 or better. Selection is based on review of the student's transcripts.

## Conditions of the Scholarship

- Must begin within one year after it is offered. If you will not enroll for the first time until the spring semester, you must, in writing, notify the Office of Financial Aid by August 1st. You may not attend another institution during the fall semester.
- Must be a full-time student at UNK (12 or more credit hours) each semester. Failure to enroll for a semester will result in forfeiture of the scholarship. Enrollment status will be checked on the last day of the first week of classes (drop and add week). The scholarship will be canceled and forfeited if you are not at full-time status at that time. Once the scholarship is lost, it will not be reinstated.
- Cannot be transferred to another institution, this includes the University of Nebraska Medical Center.
- May not be used during summer sessions.
- Eligibility will end upon receipt of a bachelor's degree or after eight semesters, whichever comes first.
- The Transfer Scholarship is in part a tuition waiver. The total of all tuition waivers received by a student cannot exceed the total tuition charge incurred during each semester. Your scholarship award amount may be adjusted if you receive more than one tuition waiver.
