Position Description

Job Description:

Study Group Leaders (SGLs) coordinate with tutors to lead group-based study sessions for a particular course. They are responsible for communicating consistently with tutors to be thoroughly prepared for each study group session. SGLs work with Learning Commons staff to determine the best days and times for study group sessions based on student availability and interest. SGLs use group-facilitation techniques to ensure that students have opportunities to become more independent and confident in their studies.

Qualifications:

In order to qualify for a Study Group Leader position, applicants must:

possess the following work habits and interpersonal skills:

- Sincere desire to serve the campus community
- Collaborative demeanor with supervisors and fellow workers
- Independently dependable and responsible
- Inviting and engaging with new people
- Creativity and flexibility when helping others learn

meet the following academic standards:

- Be a UNK student (Undergraduate and Graduate students encouraged to apply)
- Have and maintain minimum 3.2 GPA in the *subject* the applicant wishes to support
- Have and maintain a minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA
- Communicate clearly in English

Application:

Completed applications must be submitted by posted deadlines and include the following two (2) items:

- 1) Completed application form including:
 - One (1) UNK faculty recommendations addressing competence in the target language (forms included in this packet)
 - One academic advisor recommendation addressing general work habits and interpersonal skills (form included in this packet)
- 2) Current unofficial transcript (this can be printed from myBlue)

Provisions:

Contract renewable on a semester basis provided:

- a. The SGL achieves acceptable academic progress
- b. The SGL fulfills responsibilities outlined in the SGL contract
- c. A need for the SGL exists in the designated academic area
- d. The SGL abides by the laws, policies, and regulations of the institution and local, state, and federal governments.

Hours/Salary:

SGLs co-plan and co-host 1-2 study group sessions per week. Study Group Leaders are paid a competitive hourly wage that increases with experience.
