Position Description

Job Description:

Subject tutors work directly with students in small group and one-on-one settings to help students become more confident and independent in their academic work. Tutors are responsible for asking students questions and inviting them to perform tasks that ensure active learning and problem solving. Tutors help students identify and evaluate important study skills and develop a plan for improvement. Tutors refer students to other appropriate resources to help support their growth, including faculty members, study groups, Success Coaches, and advisors.

Qualifications:

In order to qualify for a Subject Tutor position, applicants must:

possess the following work habits and interpersonal skills:

- Sincere desire to serve the campus community
- Collaborative demeanor with supervisors and fellow workers
- Independently dependable and responsible
- Inviting and engaging with new people

meet the following academic standards:

- Be a UNK student (Undergraduate and Graduate students encouraged to apply)
- Have and maintain minimum 3.2 GPA in each *subject* the applicant wishes to tutor
- Have and maintain a minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA
- Communicate clearly in English

Application:

Completed applications must be submitted by <u>5 p.m. Friday</u>, <u>November 18</u> and include the following two (2) items:

- 1) Completed application form including:
 - Two (2) UNK faculty recommendations addressing competence in the subject area (forms included in this packet)
 - One academic advisor recommendation addressing general work habits and interpersonal skills (form included in this packet)
- 2) Current unofficial transcript (this can be printed from myBlue)

Provisions:

Contract renewable on a semester basis provided:

- a. The tutor maintains the minimum GPAs outlined above
- b. The tutor satisfactorily fulfills responsibilities outlined in their contract
- c. A need for the tutor still exists
- d. Satisfactorily fulfills tutor training expectations

Hours/Salary:

New tutors must work at least 8 hours per week in their first semester. After the first semester, Subject Tutors are contracted to work 4-19 hours per week as they prefer and as scheduling and budgeting allows. Tutors are paid a competitive hourly wage that increases with certification.
