

RETROACTIVE CREDIT MATH DEPARTMENT

Students entering UNK with a particularly high level of achievement in Math may be awarded credit upon completion of a “validating” course at UNK. Students must be enrolled as degree-seeking students at UNK in order to receive credit.

Students who have completed a full year of Calculus in high school may enroll in an advanced Math class. If they earn at least a “C” then they will earn 5 or 10 hours of credit for the course(s) they skipped.

- a) The validating course must be the first college level course completed in Math at the University of Nebraska at Kearney.
- b) The student must receive a letter grade of “C” or better in the validating course and may not repeat the course for the purpose of requesting credits under this policy.

After completion of a validating course listed below with a “C” or better, the student is eligible for the following credits:
