- If the student has a pathway available to apply (2024 catalog and forward), you can select the apply pathway button towards the top. This will populate a sequence of courses for their major determined by the department. If you're in the side-by-side view, the apply pathway button will be displayed on the left.
  - Note: This pathway will not account for minors, the 120 hour minimum requirement, or the 40 hours of upper division requirement, experiential learning, etc., so additional courses may need to be added.

- If classes in the pathway were previously taken in semesters prior to the start of the pathway (dual enrollment, transfer, etc.), the requirements will not display in the standard semester of the pathway
- In pathways, placeholder requirements (requirements that are a group of options instead of a specific course) have dotted lines around them. Clicking the placeholder requirement will display the course options on the right
- In the example below, selecting the BS Science-Related Course Requirements will display MATH 120 and MATH 123. Dragging either of these courses into the plan will cause the selected course to replace the placeholder.

- If you want to add a requirement (like a LOPER category) where you want to leave it up to the student to decide which course within that category, you can select Requirement and search for it in the search bar

- The Search Courses option will pull up a search feature on the right that will let you search for courses by semester(s), the requirement it fulfills, instructor, department, attribute, and number of credits. These courses can then be dragged to the semester being planned

- Selecting Activity will let you enter a non-course activity and add an optional activity type

- For adding classes, you also have the option to view the student's requirements while viewing the planner by clicking the edit in planner button

- You can then drag a class or requirement from the side view to the semester you are planning for

- If a class has pre-requisites that have not been met, this will be indicated on the course once it has been added
