REQUIREMENTS

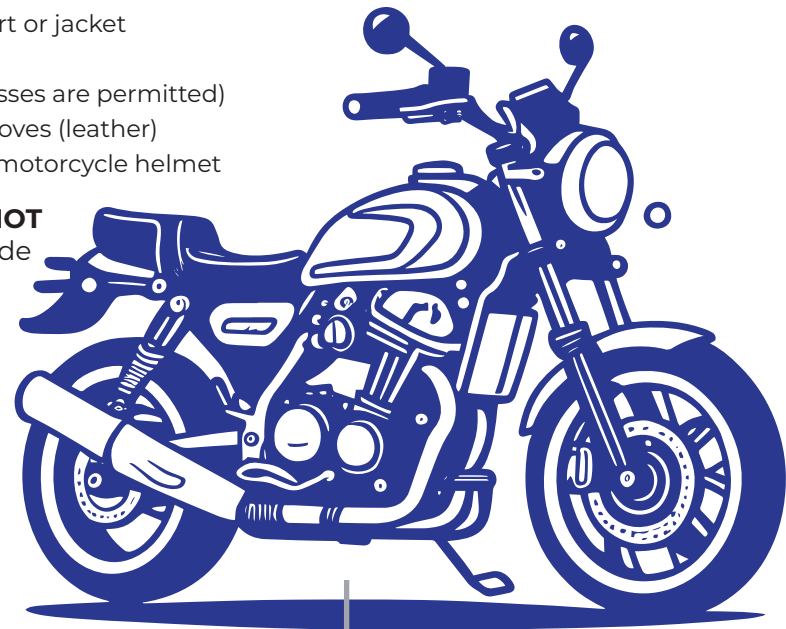

- Be at least 16 years old with a valid Operator's License. A parent, or legal guardian, **MUST** sign required waiver for riders who are under 19.
- Be capable of controlling a motorcycle, including a good sense of balance, and possess the ability to ride a bicycle.
- Attend ALL on-cycle and classroom sessions, and pass both the knowledge and riding skills evaluation.
- Know that the instructor has the final authority in determining if a participant shall be permitted to participate in any portion of the course.
- Provide your own protective gear, which consists of:
  - Over-the-ankle footwear
  - Long-sleeve shirt or jacket
  - Eye protection (glasses/sunglasses are permitted)
  - Full-fingered gloves (leather)
  - DOT-approved motorcycle helmet
- Participants will **NOT** be permitted to ride without this protective gear!

### Rescheduling Fee

A change of class date may be possible, pending availability of seats. This request must be made by the Monday prior to your scheduled class. A \$50.00 rescheduling fee will be required after two course reschedules.

There will be no refunds after the Monday prior to class except for documented emergencies.

### Cancellation Policy

Participant: To receive a refund, notification must be made more than 5 calendar days prior to the start of the course, less \$25 processing fee.

No refunds will be made to participants that cancel with less than 5 days notice, are late to a class, dismissed, counseled out, voluntarily leave, do not pass a written or riding evaluation, have previously rescheduled or missed a segment of either course.

Nebraska Safety Center: Classes may be canceled without notice due to inclement weather, lack of registrations, or other unforeseen problems. In such cases, participants will receive a full refund or may reschedule for a new class date.

### BRC (Basic Rider Course) - \$250

BRC provides the rider with basic formal instruction. This weekend course is composed of approximately 5 hours of classroom and 10 hours of range instruction. Motorcycles are provided for use during the course. MSF and DMV require successful completion (80% or better) of an approximately 3-hour eCourse prior to coming to this class. The eCourse requires the student to have access to a computer with high-speed Internet with Adobe Flash Player and their own unique email address. The eCourse cannot be completed on a cell phone.

### BRC2 (Basic Rider Course 2) - \$150 (Minimum age 19, 1 year experience)

BRC 2 is designed for experienced motorcycle riders. This 8-hour course enhances riding skills. MSF and DMV require successful completion (80% or better) of an approximately 2-hour eCourse prior to coming to this class. The eCourse requires the student to have access to a computer with high-speed Internet with Adobe Flash Player and their own unique email address. The eCourse cannot be completed on a cell phone.
