- “Driver Reinstatement, Improvement, and Vehicle Education” is an 8-hour Nebraska DMV-approved driver improvement course emphasizing vehicle control, attitude, judgment, risk management, decision-making, and personal responsibility. Material from the Nebraska Driver’s manual is also covered.
- Class times are 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. This includes the DMV-required 8 hours of classroom instruction and a 30-minute lunch break. Lunch is on your own.
- You are welcome to bring an interpreter to class, if needed.
- If you will need accommodations according to the ADA guidelines, please notify the Nebraska Safety Center office at 308-865-8562.
- A comprehensive examination is given at the end of class. Participants must score at least 80% to pass the class. If a score of at least 80% is not attained, he/she has 30 days to re-test at no charge. After 30 days, the course fee will be re-assessed.
- **\$50.00 rescheduling fee will be charged to any participant who does not attend the course as registered.**
