ADVISING STUDENT ORGANIZATIONS

Revised as of September 2022

All student organizations need an advisor in their organization. This advisor must be a UNK faculty or staff member. An advisor has many responsibilities, including but not limited to:

- 1. Meet with the student organization leaders to discuss upcoming meetings, programs, long-term plans, goals, and problem solving. Attend as many functions and formals of organization as possible.
- 2. Attend general, special, and executive board meetings as often as possible. Assist student organization in monitoring and adhering to the budget.
- 3. Explain and clarify University policies and procedures that apply to the student organization.
- 4. Communicate with the organization regarding appropriate behavior on the part of the members and possible consequences of unacceptable behavior.
- 5. Attend update and training sessions for advisors as held by the Office of Student Engagement.
- 6. If relevant, be familiar with the national structure and services provided by affiliated bodies (e.g., national organization of fraternities and sororities)
- 7. Be knowledgeable of the organization's constitution and bylaws.
