The Health Science Education Complex is a partnership between UNK and the UNMC Colleges of Nursing and Allied Health Professions, delivering high quality health profession education. This stateof-the-art facility houses more than a dozen programs, including nursing, radiologic technology, physician assistant studies, physical therapy, occupational therapy, medical laboratory science, medical nutrition, and cardiovascular interventional technology education.

NEW! In 2023, we broke ground to add a second, larger facility to further grow our state's talent pipeline in the health sciences. This new Rural Health Education Building will expand current programs and bring new options to the UNK campus, including medicine, pharmacy, public health, respiratory therapy, and mental health – all high-need areas in rural Nebraska.

STUDENT SERVICES

UNK students in Health Sciences receive **ASSISTANCE** in numerous ways. Academic advising helps students choose the **BEST COURSE** of study to provide the appropriate academic background for their chosen program, as well as assisting them to choose the career best suited for their **INTERESTS AND ABILITIES**. Help with the application process is also available. The department provides current information about health careers, professional schools, and clinical programs and sponsors speakers, workshops, meetings, a Health Science Club, AED: The Health Pre-Professional Honor Society and other activities for students.



ACCEPTANCE RATES

Admission to clinical programs and professional schools is highly competitive and never guaranteed. However, UNK is very proud of student success in gaining admission. The overall acceptance rate of UNK students to all various health programs has been over 80% for the last ten years. Here are the acceptance rates for individual programs over recent years.
