

## **New and Transfer Students**

All admitted students are required to submit an official copy of the required immunizations records.

### **Health Requirements**

To ensure the public health of our campus community, all enrolled students are required to submit a copy of their immunization records showing two measles, mumps, and rubella (MMR) vaccinations or a positive rubeola and mumps titer.

### **Requirement Details**

Immunization records must:

- Show proof of two separate MMR shots showing month, day and year it was given OR students can submit a copy of a positive rubeola and mumps blood titer lab result showing immunity. The first shot must have been received no earlier than a student's first birthday, and the second shot must have been received at least 28 days later.
- Include the full legal name of the student and the student's birthdate.
- Be in English

Immunization records can often be found at:

- Previous high school
- Previous university/college
- Health care provider's office
- Public health department
- Military record
- Nebraska residents and individuals who were immunized in the state of Nebraska may be able to access their records online at the [Nebraska State Immunization Information System \(NESIIS\)](#).

Students who need MMR immunizations or a rubeola and mumps blood titer because they cannot find their records can call 308-865-8218 to schedule an appointment at UNK Student Health. Please note immunizations or laboratory services will incur a charge. Students can also contact their preferred health care provider to receive this service.

### **Upload Records to MyBlue**

Students must upload their MMR immunization or rubeola and mumps blood titer records to MyBlue before classes begin. Failure to submit these records results in a hold preventing registration of classes.

**Step 1:** Log into [My Blue](#)

**Step 2:** Select the Profile tab on the left side of the page. Click the link “Immunization.”

**Step 3:** Enter the dates of your immunizations.

**Step 4:** Upload a PDF of your records and click Submit. If you had a hold on your account, the hold will be removed within 5 business days of clicking Submit.

Remember, the form cannot be submitted until the relevant immunization record is attached to the form. However, the form can be saved until a later date when students are ready to attach the relevant immunization record to the form and submit it.

*If immunization record can't be found:*

You have two options:

1. Receive two MMR immunizations at Student Health scheduled 28 days apart. Appointments are required. Call 308-865-8218 to schedule. This will incur a cost and the patient will be responsible for the bill.

**-OR-**

2. Have a rubeola and mumps blood test drawn at Student Health or at another physician's office and bring the test record to the health center. This blood test will look for antibodies to measles and mumps, to determine if a person is immune to the diseases. Appointments are required for this test. Please call 308-865-8218 to schedule an appointment.
