#### **Data Reporting Reminders:**

- •For four-year institutions, reporting enrollment by selected fields of study is **mandatory** this year. In Part A, enrollment in the selected fields will need to be reported on separate screens in addition to the total enrollment reported on the summary screens (CIP 99.0000).
- •Part B, Enrollment of students by age, is **optional** this year.
- Part C, Residence of first-time degree/certificate-seeking undergraduate students, is required this year.
