OUTSIDE SCHOLARSHIPS

Apply for all local, regional, and national scholarship for which you qualify.

PARENT PLUS LOAN

A federal loan in your parent's name that can be applied for and taken out to cover your remaining bill.

PRIVATE STUDENT LOAN

A loan in either your name or your parent's name that is through a private lender and can be applied for/borrowed to cover your remaining bill.

LOPER PAYMENT PLAN

Each semester bill can be paid in full by the due date, or you can pay three (3) scheduled payments (33%) with Nelnet each semester, for which there is an enrollment fee of \$20. Sign up for the Loper Payment Plan through the student's MyBLUE account once your bill has been received.
