

⇒ To register for Class B and Passenger Endorsement theory training select Register on the far right side. You may need to minimize your screen or scroll left to right at the bottom.




⇒ To register for any other courses, find the class you would like to attend and click on "View Course Details"



Level I

Students must comply with the following requirements: Complete the <u>Pre-Service Evaluation</u> and Behind the wheel training to become qualified to drive. The form must be uploaded to the driver's profile in the <u>Pupil Transportation Database</u> by either school or driver.


If a driver will ONLY be driving a small vehicle, they must attend the first three hours of the Level I they are registered for.

If you are attending, the class via zoom directions will be emailed directly to the driver a few days before class. Test your technology ahead of your zoom class. We have limited time to troubleshoot the day of the course. Make sure your equipment is ready to go.


If the vehicle requires the driver to hold a CDL, the applicant must hold a Learner's Permit for Commercial Vehicles (CLP) prior to the 'behind the wheel' evaluation. In order to obtain the CLP the applicant must pass a general knowledge written examination based on the information contained in the CDL Manual.

⇒ To double check if you are enrolled in the class go back out to Dashboard and the class will be listed.




⇒ On your dashboard you have the ability to drop the course if you need to. Then you can re-sign up for a class.




⇒ The database will not allow a driver to register for a Level II course until 4 years have passed the date of the Level I course.


- ⇒ Pre-Service Evaluation Forms need to be submitted before a driver can drive with students.
